



Income tax returns deadline further extended

30 November 2020 - The Minister of Finance has further extended the deadline for the electronic submission of personal income tax returns and the settlement of the relevant income tax liability for the tax year 2019, from 30 November to 15 December.

The relevant Ministry Decree ([562/2020](#)) was published in the official Government Gazette on 27 November 2020.

The decree provides that the deadline for the electronic submission of the 2019 personal income tax return (Form T.D.1) for employees and pensioners, whose total gross annual income exceeds €19,500, is extended to 15 December 2020. The extension also applies to the payment of the related income tax due, as per the submitted T.D.1, via self-assessment.

Additionally, the deadline for the electronic submission of the 2019 income tax returns for self-employed persons (Form T.D.1 self-employed) with a turnover below €70,000 and who do not have the obligation to submit audited accounts, is also extended from 30 November 2020 to 15 December 2020. The extension also applies to the payment of the relevant income tax due, as per the submitted return, via self-assessment.
